DIRECTIONS

From points south:

Take I-93 north to Derry/ Londonderry Exit 4. Take a left at the end of the ramp. Take 102 west for approx. 3 miles to Rte. 128/Mammoth Road (Seven traffic lights including the ramp). Take a right on Mammoth Road by the Homestead Restaurant. Go north one mile... you can't miss the orchard farm stand!

From points north:

Take I-93 south to Derry/ Londonderry Exit 4. Take a right at the end of the ramp. Take 102 west for approx. 3 miles to Rte. 128/Mammoth Road (Six traffic lights including ramp). Take a right on Mammoth Road by the Homestead Restaurant. Go north one mile... you can't miss the orchard farm stand!

From Manchester:

Take South Willow to Londonderry. About a mile south of the Yard Restaurant, bear off to the right at the Mobil station onto Mammoth Road. The orchard farm stand is about 4 miles down, on the left.
