<b>Cultivar/selection</b>	White Gold
<b>Rootstock</b>	G6
<b>Cracking</b>	about 50%?
<b>Yield</b>	very heavy
<b>Fruit shape</b>	slight heart
<b>Skin color</b>	red-yellow
<b>Stem length</b>	short-medium
<b>Fruit weight grams</b>	7.4
<b>Row size</b>	10.5
<b>Flesh color</b>	yellow
<b>Juice color</b>	clear-yellow
<b>Soluble solids</b>	14.9



**Comments** very heavy crop, seems to be prone to splits/cracking; needs aggressive crop load management

<b>Skin color</b>	red
<b>Stem length</b>	medium
<b>Fruit weight grams</b>	8
<b>Row size</b>	10
<b>Flesh color</b>	light red
<b>Juice color</b>	red
<b>Soluble solids</b>	16.3



**Comments** classic red cherry; small fruit size, but over-cropped

<b>Skin color</b>	red
<b>Stem length</b>	long
<b>Fruit weight grams</b>	7.3
<b>Row size</b>	10.5
<b>Flesh color</b>	red
<b>Juice color</b>	red
<b>Soluble solids</b>	17.3



**Comments** rather unexceptional, but OK; crack-resistant; variable fruit size, larger ones ripe, smaller ones don't look ripe

<b>Rootstock</b>	G5
<b>Cracking</b>	some, stem end
<b>Yield</b>	moderate
<b>Fruit shape</b>	oblate
<b>Skin color</b>	maroon
<b>Stem length</b>	short-medium
<b>Fruit weight grams</b>	9.5
<b>Row size</b>	9.5
<b>Flesh color</b>	red
<b>Juice color</b>	dark red
<b>Soluble solids</b>	16.5



**Comments** some trees badly split; variable fruit size; birds, rot, defects; needs to be covered then would be very good cherry; somewhat canker-susceptible
